\*Synchronous learning - a learning event in which a group of students and an educator are engaging in learning at the same time (e.g. Google Meeting or Zoom Meeting).

\*\*Asynchronous learning - the idea that students learn the same material at different times and locations (e.g. Learning practice activity posted in Google Classroom).
